### 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Shenandoah Valley Heritage Ride

9<sup>th</sup> Annual Shenandoah Valley Heritage Ride to support the KIDS CLUBS of Northern Shenandoah Valley will be held on Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup>. The ride will be through the historic countryside of the Shenandoah Valley. Our ride begins in Winchester and rolls through Frederick County where you will be surrounded by Civil War history at every turn. This is a self-paced ride for everyone from the recreational to the serious cyclist. Brochure is attached.

**Distance:** There will be ride routes from 10, 30, 50, or 70 miles.

**Where:** All Routes will start and finish at Valley Health Wellness & Fitness Center, 401 Campus Blvd., Winchester, VA 22601.

**When:** **04 June, 2017**. Start time is **9:00AM** for the 30, 50, & 70 mile rides. Start time is **9:10AM** for the 10 mile ride.

**Other:** We are still waiting for head count of participants. Once that is received and we have an idea of needs, Winchester Wheelmen will be soliciting support from its members for monetary donations to help pay for the kids' bikes and accessories. Look for this to happen during the month of April.



# **West Virginia Getaway!**

**June 8<sup>th</sup> thru June 11<sup>th</sup>**

**Please join us for a long weekend of riding and relaxing in Central West Virginia. We will be staying at a Cabin just south of Canaan Valley. Cabin is located on 20 acres of private land. There is no charge for the cabin rental.**

**Cabin is able to sleep 6 to 8, plus I will bring the camper, which sleeps 4 and you are always welcome to camp. The cabin has 2 bedrooms, loft area, full kitchen and living area, 2 full baths and there is also a large storage barn near where the camping sites are.**

**We will be road biking, mountain biking, hiking (where we can do a little caving, if interested) and site seeing.**

**We are planning on going up on Thursday, June 8, leaving in the later afternoon. We will settle in, have a nice camp fire and have dinner at the cabin. Travel time is just about 2 1/2 hours.**

**On Friday, We will travel to Spruce Knob for a day of Mt. Biking, hiking and caving. If you don't feel like hiking or biking, please feel free to explore the towns of Davis and Thomas and visit Blackwater Falls. That evening we will have dinner at the cabin again.**

**On Saturday, we will travel to Scenic Highway 150 for a 42 mile road ride. This is a beautiful, noncommercial highway. Lunch will be served at the half way point and the ride will be sagged. The ride is similar to Skyline Drive. You can choose to do all or part of the ride, as it is an out and back. When we get back to the cabin we will get ready, have dinner in Davis and go enjoy a little music at the Purple Fiddle in Thomas. May have to dance a little too.**

**Sunday will be a travel day home, but remember to either stop by Seneca Rocks on the way back home, you are welcome to hike there or just take in the views. You can also travel back to Davis and enjoy the town and Blackwater Falls, if you did not get there earlier. Both are great.**

**You are more then welcome to come up for all or part of the activities. If you would like a more private stay, Canaan Valley State Park is only about 20 minutes from the cabin and they have wonderful accommodations.**

### Weekday/Weeknight/Weekend Rides & Events

Approved helmets are required for all rides. If you are not a club member, you must sign a waiver prior to the ride. For all scheduled rides with a designated ride leader, please contact the leader for details (confirmation that the ride is a 'go', weather concerns, other). **Mondays - Road Ride - Frederick County, VA.** Meet at White Hall Methodist Church, White Hall, VA at **6:15PM** for a road ride. Robert Golightly is leading. Ride distance is about 25 miles 540-535-9986

**Mondays- Casual Road ride- Frederick County, Va.** Will meet at the above at 5:30 instead of 6:15. Ride distance is about 15 miles. Call Susan at 540-247-7706 or email at [susanwwalker@comcast.net](mailto:susanwwalker@comcast.net) for more information.

**Tuesdays - Road Ride - Stephens City, VA.** Meet at Food Lion Plaza east of Stephens City on VA 277 for the **6:00PM** ride start. This is not a beginner ride; the pace is 17-19mph for the slower group, 19+ for the faster group. Typical loop is here: <http://www.ridewithgps.com/routes/102730> Distance is TBD by participants due to available daylight constraints. Please have a white front light and red rear flasher. There is no ride leader.

**Wednesdays - Road Ride - Frederick County, VA.** Road ride starting from Fellowship Bible Church and the time is **6:00PM**. The ride will start with the Germany loop and then follow the old Wednesday night ride loop. The distance is 23 miles and the pace WILL be in the 15-16 mph range and we'll regroup during the ride. This will be a little faster and a little longer version of the old Wednesday night ride. DJ Arnold is leading and may be reached at [ti22c6@yahoo.com](mailto:ti22c6@yahoo.com).

**Thursdays - Night Road Ride - White Post, VA.** This ride is a "go" unless there is rain or snow. Ride starts from White Post Restorations. Ride departs promptly at **6:10PM**. Average speed is 15-17mph. There is no ride leader.

**Thursday - Night Casual Ride- white Post, Va. This is the same ride as above, but will start at 5:30pm and will be at a slower pace. Call Susan for more information at 540-247-7706 or email at [susanwwalker@comcast.net](mailto:susanwwalker@comcast.net).**

**Thursdays - Retired/Day - Off Ride of the Week** This is an easy-paced ride starting at various locations. Ride length is between 20 to 30 miles usually with a lunch stop at the finish (optional). (No ride leaders here, just advisors.) The rides will start at **10:00AM** for April at the following locations:

--April 6th--Meet at the parking lot across from St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Strasburg, located at 156 W. Washington Street

--April 13th--Meet in parking lot of Santorini's Grill in Berryville. Park in the back.

--April 20st--Meet at the Italian Touch in Middletown, VA. Park in the back.

--April 27th--Meet at Rock Harbor Golf Course. Park to the left.

**Release and Assumption of Risk**

This is a legal Document. Please read and understand before signing. If you have any questions consult an attorney.

In consideration of my participation, I waive, release, discharge for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and legal representatives (including successors) any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may hereafter accrue to me against the sponsors and promoters of the Shenandoah Valley Heritage Ride (SVHR) or other sponsors or affiliated organizations and their respective agents, officers and employees for any and all damages, injuries or claims which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly and arising out of my participation in the SVHR.

I, the undersigned, freely acknowledge and realize the dangers of participating in the SVHR and fully assume all risks including, but not limited to: collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, and/or fixed or moving objects; the negligence of other riders, sponsors, promoters, or drivers; and dangers arising from falls, road surface, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment and weather conditions as well as the possibility of physical and/or mental trauma (or injury). I understand that any route or activity chosen as part of outdoor adventure may not be the safest, especially bicycling public roadways and in bad weather, that cyclists have been hospitalized and/or killed because of traffic mishaps that are either their responsibility or others' responsibilities. I further agree that I will bear all expenses incurred in any such accidents.

I realize that SVHR requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical impediment which would endanger others or myself. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during SVHR which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters or organizers and agree to ride so as not to endanger either others or myself.

I will wear an ANSI or SNELL certified helmet when riding a bike during SVHR. I will obey all VA traffic laws and regulations. I understand that if I leave the route I am no longer on the ride. I agree that my photograph, video or voice may be used in promotion or advertising for SVHR with no compensation due.

The above agreements and representations are my express understandings of the risks and I assume these voluntarily and freely without coercion or duress. This agreement may not be modified orally and may not be waived in any respect. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle and agree to abide by the rules of SVHR relating to wearing a helmet, riding single file, appropriate behavior, as well as other organization requirements.

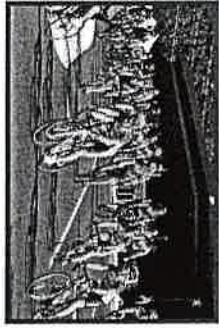
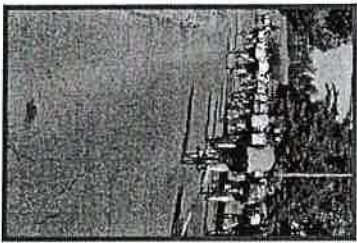

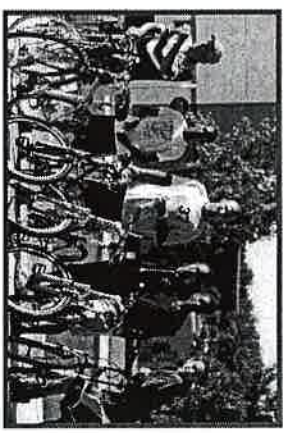
